Dear Sirs,

I am in receipt of Mr. Boyd's letter of the 14th instant enclosing plan of the main bailers and particulars of the shafting of the S.S. "SPIRAL". It is noted that the boilers have been examined and the dimensions and scantlings have been found to be in accordance with the drawing; further that the intermediate and screw shafts are in accordance with the Society's Rules provided the propeller is not more than 11 feet in diameter; and that the crank and thrust shafts are .04 smaller than required by the Society's Rules, and I have to acquaint you that in the circumstances this vessel's machinery will be approved for the record of LMC with date, when a satisfactory report has been received.

The boiler plan is returned herewith.
