A message has been received from the Middlesbrough Surveyors
stating that this new steamer has received some slight damage
to the bottom plating on the port side in launching.

It was intended to dock the vessel on the Tyne and
effect the necessary repairs, but as the owners are
anxious to have the vessel as early as possible in service
on a charter, it is proposed, until the damage can be effected,
a temporary repair effect on the wharf, so that the
vessel will be dry docked for repairs after the
present voyage.

The Surveyors found the damage to be
slightly indented and a few small holes in the
way of same started, and they are of opinion that
satisfactory temporary repairs can be effected.
