A letter has been received from the Middlesbrough Surveyors stating that this new Steamer has received some slight damage to the bottom plating on the port side in launching.

It was intended to dock the vessel on the Tyne and effect the necessary repairs, but as the Owners are anxious to have the vessel as early as possible to save a charter, it is proposed, with the Owners consent, to effect a temporary repair afloat, on the understanding that the vessel will be dry docked for permanent repairs after the present voyage.

The Surveyors found on examination that a plate is slightly indented and a few seam rivets and the caulking in way of same started, and they are of opinion that satisfactory temporary repairs can be effected.

The Builders are anxious to know if the proposal will affect the vessel's classification and issue of certificates, and the Surveyors request a reply by wire.

It is submitted the Surveyors be informed that provided the temporary repairs be carried out to their satisfaction and the vessel be reported in their first entry report to have been built in accordance with the Rules and the approved plans she will be eligible to be recommended to the Committee for classification, subject to permanent repairs
