Stranded and Pitted. Recommend the stay
to be renewed. Lower screw eyes and
Shackles of the Fore and Main Riggings
worn in the tips. Recommend these to be
fired made workable, and repaired where
necessary. Chain Plate eyes to be examined
when exposed. Masts, Spars, other Rigging
and Ironwork in good condition*
