Vessel's Name S.S. "TAFFARI"

No.1 War M-R in Supplement, may come to Algiers for permanent repairs after temporary at Oran. I understand the Underwriters salvage Surveyor has telegraphed costs obtained which show a saving of 2,000,000 francs from the excessive insured value for T.L. or C.T.L.

It is submitted that the Society's Surveyor at Algiers should be asked to advise this Office as soon as possible if the vessel arrives at his port, and to state whether or not permanent repairs will then be carried out at Algiers, or what other arrangements may be made.
