Dear Sir,


I was recently approached by the Owner of the S.S. "TAFFARI", ex "WAR MYSTERY", who informed me that he proposed making at this port, during discharging of cargo and reloading, certain modifications which they had found necessary and for which he desired the approval of the Society. I replied that, as no exclusive Surveyor is resident at this port, I could accept no responsibility as regards such work, but that, if he so desired I would appoint a Surveyor to control the modifications and would forward his report to you. If the modifications did not affect the seaworthiness of the vessel I had no doubt they would be approved. This was agreed to and I beg to enclose herewith Survey Report, which I trust will be found in order.

Under the circumstances, I have issued no certificate and would be obliged if you would be good enough to communicate your approval, provided you agree to what has been done, direct to the Owners. The Surveyor states that all the alterations made are reasonable and for the more efficient working of the vessel.
