Steel Screw Steamers Nos. 8, 9, 10, 11 & 12 proposed to be built by Messrs. J.F.Duthie & Co. of Seattle with a view to class 100A1.

Rule Dimensions: 410.45 x 54 x 29.75

These vessels are proposed to be built as duplicates of the S.S. No. 5 building by The Northwest Steel Co., in which case a proposal to dispense with the intermediate bulkheads in the forward and after holds was approved, subject to a notation being made in the Register Book and to a letter being received from the Owners in regard to the arrangement of bulkheads, the plans being approved by Mr. French on the 15th June last.

It is submitted that provided a satisfactory report be received on completion, the vessels will be eligible to be classed 100A1, subject to a letter being received from the Owners and to a notation being made in the Register Book in regard to the omission of the intermediate bulkheads in the forward and after holds.
