
Nature of Survey

The Hartlepool Surveyors now report the vessel has been examined afloat.

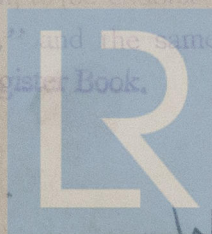
A new quadrant has been fitted to rudder head.
