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Nature of Survey

The Barry Surveyors report two trimming holes have been cut in bridge space about 10 feet forward of cross bunker hatch. As a temporary measure, flat plates have been fitted over same, and the Surveyors recommend suitable coamings be fitted at the first opportunity.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed, without fresh record of survey, subject to suitable coamings being fitted to two trimming hatches in bridge space at the first opportunity.
