

**NOTES AS TO RECORD OF OWNERSHIP.**

- (1) The name given in Lloyd's Register Book is intended to be that of the Registered Owner who manages the vessel, or preferably that of the firm (if any) in which he is a partner. If the Registered Owner is the representative (President, Secretary, &c.) of a Company, the name of the Company should be given.
  - (2) If the management of the vessel is not in the hands of any Registered Owner, the name of the largest Shareholder should be given, and in addition the name of the Manager.
  - (3) In the case of a "single-ship" company (i.e., a company owning only one vessel and named after that vessel), the Managers' names will be recorded after the name of the Company, thus:—"Ship Argo Co. (Robinson & Smith)."
- In cases referred to under (2) and (3) vessels will appear only under the names of the Managers in the List of Owners, but the names of both Owners and Managers will be given in the body of the Register Book.


