T.S. Motor Vessel "Sebastian"

This vessel was built in 1914 & fitted with 2 Stroke Cycle oil Engines manufactured by Messrs the Aker-Diesels Motoren Stockholm. As these Engines did not give satisfaction they were replaced in June last year by Engines of the 4 Stroke Cycle type manufactured by the Warkspoor Co at Amsterdam.

The 1st Annual Survey which becomes due in June next has now been held at Cardiff & it would appear from the Surveyors' report that the parts examined were found in good condition, repairs only of a very minor character being found necessary. The machinery was afterwards tested satisfactorily under working conditions.

The 2 HP air & fuel receivers which were tested but not made under the supervision of the Amsterdam Surveyors & which were recommended to be replaced by others which had been built under survey at the Owners Convenience have again been examined & tested but not renewed.
