

Motor Vessel "SEBASTIAN" - about 3300 tons gross.

This vessel is building by the Caledon Shipbuilding Engineering Co. for Messrs. Lane & MacAndrew with a tonnage to class 100A 1 "Carrying oil in bulk". The Owners state that she was launched on the 24th April 1913, but due to various unforeseen delays which have occurred in fitting the motors they are now only being tried on board ship, and it will be a little time yet before the vessel is actually completed. They therefore request that the date of build may be entered in the Register Book from the time of her completion. They state that when the vessel was launched she was drydocked and painted in August last, and she is again in dry dock for the same purpose.

The Rules state that in the case of vessels built without special survey the date of completion of special survey will be taken as the date of build of the vessel and the survey be completed within six months of the date of launching, for vessels not exceeding 10,000 tons gross.

It is submitted for the consideration of the Committee whether in the circumstances the date of completion should be entered as the date of build as desired by the Owners.

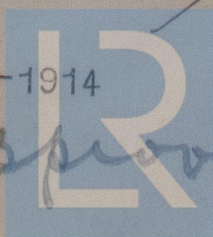
