

Wreck 149.

VOLMER (s).—*Penzance*, Dec. 28, 8 30 p.m.—
Captain and one sailor landed here this evening both
much exhausted and now in hospital. They are
believed to be from steamer Volmor or Volmer, of
Copenhagen, from Swansea. Steamer foundered. Men
in boat two days; remainder of crew supposed drowned.
Hope able see captain in morning to get particulars.

Penzance, Dec. 29, 1 20 p.m.—
Steamer Volmer, of Copenhagen, from Swansea to
Nice, cargo coals, foundered during heavy gale Dec. 26,
at 3 p.m., 25 miles south of Scilly. The hatches broke
in and vessel sustained other damages. Crew took to
boats, which capsized alongside ship. Captain and
one German sailor saved by steam trawler and landed
here yesterday; both men very exhausted and still in
