

TRANSLATION OF A LETTER RECEIVED FROM JOSEPH PUPPI OF
EILLES DATED 12TH NOVEMBER, 1920.

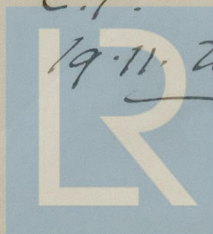
I shall feel much obliged if you will kindly see
that in the next edition of Lloyd's Register the following
notation is made, as regards my S.S. "VICTORIEUX", "Rebuilt
1920." My vessel underwent repairs for eleven months by the
Rotterdamsche Droogdok Maats., Rotterdam, the cost of which
exceeded £95,000, and I have ~~been~~ formally been assured
by my (may be your) engineer and the repairers that this
justified notation would be made in Lloyd's Register.

P.S. The notation in question has formed the subject of an
inscription on a brass plate which the Rott. Droogdok Maats.
have affixed on the forepart of the bridge in the presence
of your Superintending - Engineer at Rotterdam.

wanded to the Rotterdam Surveyors who should be
requested to forward their remarks on the same
