I have pleasure in enclosing a cutting from this publication which I trust will answer your purpose.

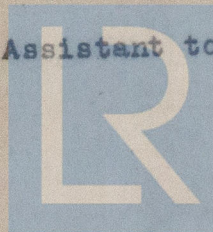
An account for the cost of the above mentioned certificates is also enclosed.
