With reference to the classification in this
S. Society's Register Book of your steamer "PORTUGAL", I beg to
acquaint you that the Committee have now had before them a
report received from the Society's Surveyors at Newport, from
which it appears that a special examination of the vessel has
been made afloat. In the circumstances the Committee have
deferred action in the matter in regard to the Special Survey
No.2, and have assigned a notation of "Examined 7.18".

I may add that the Surveyors state that several
hatch beam lugs in the 'tween deck hatchways require to be
repaired, and that your Superintendent stated that this would be
done at the first opportunity.
