Dear Sir,

With reference to the classification in the Society's Register Book of your Steamer "NOUVEAU CONSEIL", I beg to acquaint you that the Committee have had before them at their Meeting to-day a report from the Society's Surveyors at Bordeaux from which it appears that the vessel has been examined in dry dock and the survey of the boilers carried out.

The Surveyors, however, recommended that the donkey boiler should not be used until repairs had been effected, and in the circumstances a notation of B.S. 4,21. (Boilers surveyed April 1921) has been assigned subject to the donkey boiler not being used again until it has been repaired and satisfactorily reported upon by the Society's Surveyors.
