Dear Mr. Hutchinson,

I notice from to-day's Lloyd's List that the wood fore and aft Sr. "RICHARD B. SILVER" which was built last year at Meteghan River, under Special Survey, is stated to have been abandoned at Sea in a sinking condition, while on a voyage from Santos to Havre, and that the Crew have been landed at Cayenne.

In the circumstances I cabled to you as follows:-

"RICHARD B. SILVER REPORTED ABANDONED AT SEA IN SINKING
"CONDITION CREW LANDED AT CAYENNE STOP PLEASE ASCERTAIN AND
"CABLE AS FULL PARTICULARS AS POSSIBLE".
