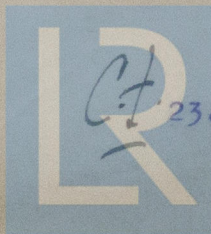


WOOD SCHOONER "RICHARD B. SILVER" built by R. H. HOWES

The plans for this vessel were approved by the New York Surveyors on the 2nd April 1918. .

The First Entry Report has now been received from the Surveyor and it is noticed that the ~~under deck~~ tonnage is more than was contemplated, this increase in tonnage is caused by an increase in the dimensions of the vessel.

The scantlings and arrangements of the vessel as given on the 1st Entry Report have been compared with the Rules and it is found that the same could be recommended to the Committee for their favourable consideration.
