

S.S. "ISLEWORTH".

Mr. Dalgliesh has called here this afternoon and stated that the above vessel has been ashore, and is now lying in Vatica Bay, on the South Coast of Greece. He stated that the fore end of the vessel has had to be removed by blasting operations in order to refloat the ship, and that this portion will require to be entirely renewed.

Mr. Dalgliesh desires to know if there are proper facilities at Piraeus - to which port he contemplates sending the vessel - for the repairs to be carried out.

It is submitted the Piraeus Surveyors might be requested, by wire, to telegraph this information to this Office by return, in order that it may be passed on to Mr. Dalgliesh as soon as possible.
