Nature of Survey

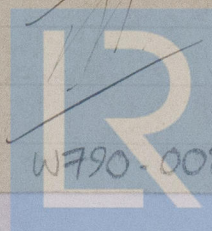
DAMAGE.

This vessel is reported by the Wellington Surveyor to have sustained damage to No. 1 hatchway &c. through heavy weather. Partial Temporary repairs have been effected to his satisfaction to enable her to proceed on her voyage to Australia.

The Surveyor recommends that the repairs be completed at the final port of discharge.
(The vessel is stated to have since sunk.)

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed without record of survey subject to permanent repairs as recommended.
