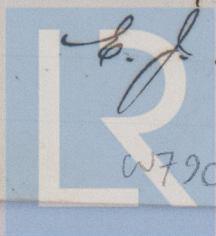
I may add that similar tests were approved for wire hawsers supplied to the ss Drayton Grange, Belfast Report no 5352.
