
Dear Sirs,

With reference to the conversation which I had the pleasure of having with one of your Representatives this morning, over the telephone, regarding the Wood Steamer "NATENNA", now at Brest, I understand from your remarks that this vessel, which stands in the Society's Register Book as owned by the United States Shipping Board, is now the property of the Nacirema Steamship Corporation, 25th Broadway, New York, and is being operated by your good selves for the above Corporation.

With regard to your Representative's remark that you are anxious that the vessel shall proceed on her intended voyage without discharging at Brest, if this course can prudently be followed, I have to say that the Committee will be pleased to instruct one of the Society's Surveyors to the above effect, and that he is to proceed to Brest for the purpose of making a survey of the steamer and cabling a Report thereon, if, as they conclude, this will meet your wishes in the matter. Perhaps you will kindly favour me with a line that the above statement represents your views.
