The following is an excerpt from specification of this vessel regarding ceiling.

"CEILING-- Over side pockets only to upper turn of bilge of 2½" pitch  
"pine and on tank tops in way of hatches only of pitch pine 2½"  
"thick. Above bilges to be 6" x 2" battens 8" space. All to  
"be secured with portable cleats, holes being punched in those  
"in deep tank to keep sparring in. All ceiling in bunkers to  
"be caulked and payed. No ceiling on tunnel. [REDACTED]."
