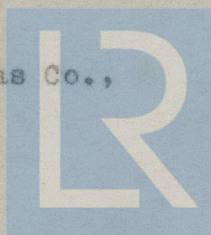
The Surveyors report that damage has been sustained to the shell plating through collision, and that temporary repairs have been effected to their satisfaction to enable her to proceed on her voyage, but he recommends that she should be dry-docked and repaired at the first opportunity convenient to your goodselves.

I may add that the vessel became due for the Special Survey No. 3 at the end of last month.
