equipment No. is now, in respect of this alteration, 46445,  
and the Builders state that the outfit is bought and made  
for the steamer.

In view of the number being only 45 over the grade,  
the equipment as supplied is, in the circumstances, submitted  
for the favourable consideration of the Committee.

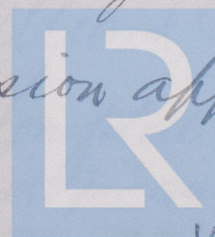
