You will remember me speaking to you when here, regarding a point that had arisen in connection with our S/S No. 569, that we had building, and sold to Messrs Shankland of Greenock.

They added 4 feet to the length of the poop; and I did not know when making the arrangement that this would affect the numeral; but it has made our Equipment Number 46445, which you will note exceeds the grade by about 44.

They have also moved the waterclosets from the inside of the forecastle to the outside of forecastle, but you may not reckon this.

We have the outfit bought and made for this steamer. If any increase is necessary, what is the easiest way to get over the difficulty?
