

S.S. "SARANAC", No. 83072 in the Register Book.

This vessel is owned by the Anglo-American Oil Co. Ltd. and is classed 100A1 Shelter deck with freeboard, "Carrying Petroleum in bulk", and was built by Messrs. Palmers Shipbuilding & Iron Co. in 1918.

A letter has now been received from the above Builders stating that they have undertaken a contract to construct a new midship portion for the length of the oil tanks of this vessel. The new part of the vessel will be an exact duplicate of that recently constructed by them for the S.S. "CADILLAC", a sister ship to the one now under consideration, and for which various plans were approved in 1929.

It is submitted the Builders be informed that their remarks are noted, and that it will not be necessary to submit fresh plans in connexion with the alterations to the S.S. "SARANAC". The Newcastle Surveyors should be requested to add this vessel's name to the plans previously approved for the "CADILLAC".

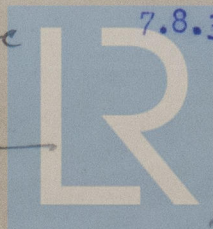
