REBUILT "CADILLAC" UNDOCKED

Palmer's Shipbuilding & Iron Company, Ltd., undocked to-day the tanker *Cadillac*, of 12,000 tons deadweight, belonging to the Anglo-American Oil Company, Ltd., which they have had in hand for seven weeks for the purpose of fitting in a new centre section over three hundred feet in length. The vessel will go on sea trials to-morrow, and then resume service. The work of building in a new centre section to an oil tanker is novel in its conception and execution, and if it proves successful this is likely to be followed by similar contracts. The fore and after ends of the ship were cut through and the new section floated into the dock and joined up.
