I am in receipt of your letter of the 18th instant enclosing plans, in triplicate, of midship section, profile and decks, and typical midship bulkhead in connexion with the new midship portion for the S.S. "CADILLAC", and I have pleasure in stating that your Mr. Dodds has called at this Office this afternoon and handed in plans of keel and middle line bulkhead, and the scantlings and arrangements have been discussed with him.

"Cadillac keel plate and centre girder plate approved
"as proposed with butts of centre bulkhead in cofferdams
"Stop. Additional butt in keel plate at aft side of
"fortyfive transverse keel plate straps old thickness".


