& Iron Co. in 1917.


A letter has been received from the Hamburg Office
stating that Messrs. Blohm & Voss have ^{submitted} ~~made~~ a tender to the
Owners, the Anglo American Oil Co.Ld., for the part
re-construction of this tanker, the midship part in way of
the tanks to be entirely reconstructed, and joined on to the
present fore and after ends.

The Owners, the Anglo American Oil Company, state (by phone)
that this is only one of the schemes they have before them for
the re-conditioning of this tanker, another one being the effect
the necessary repairs to the present structure. Nothing has
yet been settled as to what will eventually be done. or as to
whether the reconditioning of the vessel will be carried out
in this Country or in Germany.

It is submitted Mr. Chisholm might be advised that
the Owners of the vessel have informed this Office that nothing
has yet been decided as to the re-conditioning of this tanker.
