It is submitted the Belfast Surveyors should be informed that the compensation provided for the omission of rudder stops in the case of the S.S. "Star of Scotland" built under their special survey is considered satisfactory and has been approved.

The Surveyors should however be further informed that in all cases wherein the Society's Rules are being departed from in vessels building under their survey for the Society's classification they should promptly report the same to this office in order that it may be intimated to them whether or not such compensation as may be offered is considered satisfactory.

In all cases such departures from the Rules should be mentioned in the Surveyors' first entry Reports.
