Dear Sirs,

I was duly favoured with your letter of the 19th instant respecting the second bower anchor supplied by you for the steamer "OKINI" (No. 590), building by Messrs. Cochrane & sons, and with regard thereto I have to inform you that as the total weight of this anchor is 6 cwt. 0 qr. 24 lb., the weight of the head is required to be 3 cwt. 2 qr. 25 lb., being three-fifths of this total weight. As, however, the head is 19 lb. light, equal to about $5\frac{1}{5}$, it is regretted that it cannot be accepted for the figure 1 for equipment.
