Sir,

I beg to submit for the consideration of the Committee three certificates for the equipment of anchors supplied for Messrs Dechane & Sons, Steam Trawler NO 590, it will be observed that in the case of the second stockless anchor the weight of the cast steel head does not weigh  $3/5$ ths of the total weight of the anchor but is 1qr 12 lbs light in the case of the anchor supplied, and 26lbs light in the case of an anchor of the Rule weight viz;- 6cwt 0qr 0lbs.

I shall be pleased to be informed if the second anchor, may be accepted as part of the equipment of this vessel.

The approved plans of Midship section profile and Decks are also forward for reference.
