With reference to the classification in the Society's Register Book of the steamer "ONWARD HO", I beg to acquaint you that the Committee have today had before them a report from the Society's Surveyor at Monte Video, from which it appears that temporary repairs have been effected on account of damage sustained to the shell plating, etc. through grounding.

It is recommended that the vessel be placed in dry dock, the necessary repairs effected, and the machinery opened out for examination on her arrival at Vancouver, and I may add that I am communicating with the Society's Surveyor at that port with a view to the case receiving the necessary attention.
