and that I have transmitted to the Committee of Lloyd's Register of Shipping, London, a Report stating that all recommendations made by me in connection therewith have been carried out to my satisfaction, and that I have Recommended that the record of L.M.C.(G.S) with date and D.B.S. 3:40 be made in the Register Book in the case of this vessel when the survey has been completed.

Parts now examined:—

- Port Nos. 1 & 5 M.E. cylinders, pistons and rings.
- Nos. 1 & 2 M.E. crossheads, crank pins and main bearings.
- Starboard No. 3 M.E. cylinder, piston and rings.
- Nos. 3 & 5 M.E. crossheads, crank pins & main bearings.
- The lubricating oil pump over all parts.
- The propellers, all sea cocks & valves, together with their fastenings and pumping arrangements.
- The donkey Boiler internally and externally with breast cocks and water gauge cocks only. Adjusted safety valves under steam.
