Nature of Survey

The Barrow Surveyors report the vessel placed in dry dock, the bottom cleaned and coated and minor repairs carried out.

The mainmast has been reinforced and stiffened to carry a 10 ton derrick (see correspondence attached.)

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed with record of survey 4,37.
