Gentlemen,

T With reference to your reports Nos. 8891 and 8963 on the steamers "MARIE" and "NORA", the machinery for which was constructed at Sunderland and fitted on board at your port, it would appear that you have only collected, so far as the machinery is concerned, the sum of frs. 104 in each case, being your own fee for the survey during the fitting of the engines. There is still due in each case the sum of £8:4:0 for the survey of the machinery during construction, and as the machinery reports are marked "Antwerp to collect", it was apparently understood by the Society's Surveyors at Sunderland that you would obtain payment of these fees.

I shall be glad, therefore, if you will take the necessary steps in the matter and advise me, as well as the Sunderland Surveyors, when payment has been received.
