The remarks of the Chief Ship Surveyor are desired on this case for the consideration of the Classing Committee.

("The endorsement to contain a succinct summary of any repairs that have been required and to show the cause or causes of such repairs, and also to bring out clearly any exceptional features in connection with the case, so that the Classing Committee may have all the salient points presented in the endorsement."—Extract from Sub-Committee's Report, 24/5/92.)

Nature of Survey Condition

This vessel was classed "A- Hopper Barge" on the 24th ultimo, and does not yet appear to have been registered in this country.

The Rotterdam Surveyors now report that they have examined the vessel on a slipway at the special request of the Owner, and some minor alterations have been effected.

The Surveyors add that the vessel is still lying at the Builders yard and the slight alterations were seen by them while examining other work, and in these circumstances the Owner desires to have the date of build altered on the certificate to January 1913.

App. by Committee

As it would appear that the survey now held is practically a continuation of the survey for classification, it is submitted for the consideration of the Committee whether the Owners request might be acceded to, and the vessel allowed to remain as classed with record of survey 1,13 as recommended.
