I am in receipt of your letter of the 5th instant requesting a further report on the repairs to the S.S. "ORONSA", (my Report No. 74).

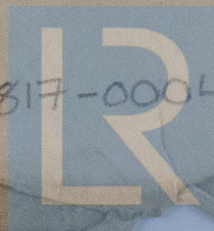
I may state that there were no structural repairs carried out at this Port as I did not think it necessary or desirable to recommend same.
