Dear Sirs,

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 26th instant, respecting the S.S. "OHIO", and note that this vessel is shortly due at Barry where she is to be handed over to the Owners by the French Marine free of requisition.

In reply I have to say that, in the special circumstances referred to, your request to carry out the Special Survey No. 1 on the present occasion, while the vessel is in dry dock thoroughly opened out, will be agreed to subject to the condition you name, viz. that the dates of the Special Surveys Nos. 2 and 3 becoming due be taken as four years and eight years respectively from the date of the present Special Survey - that is to say, December, 1920 and December, 1924.
