## CERTIFICATE FOR STEEL WIRE HAWSER.

We hereby Certify that the 240 <sup>✓</sup> meters fathoms of 4322 <sup>✓</sup> inch <sup>Diameter</sup> circumference galvanized Steel Wire Hawser supplied to Chambers D. Normandie for the Navire H3 is composed of 6 <sup>✓</sup> strands, each containing 24 <sup>✓</sup> wires of 2.34 <sup>✓</sup> inch diameter, and that the several wires, after being galvanized, have been subjected to, and have successfully withstood, the following tests, viz.:

Each wire has withstood a tensile stress at least equivalent to that set forth in Tables Nos. 30 & 31 of the Rules of Lloyd's Register of Shipping, and the aggregate strength of the wires is not less than 10 per cent. in excess of that stress.

Each wire has been twisted eight times round itself as a core, and untwisted again and straightened without fracture.

\_\_\_\_\_ guarantee that the Steel Wire Hawser of 4322 <sup>✓</sup> inches <sup>Diameter</sup> in circumference above described will bear a strain of 29 <sup>✓</sup> tons without breaking.
