In reference to your letter of the 16th instant, in regard to the Steamer "Ohio"; I beg to inform you that, the sketch showing the thickness of plating of the bridge deck, and the 2 Certificates of steel wire, have been enclosed in the same envelope with my letter of the 10th instant.

I have written to the Builder for to have copies of Certificates and another sketch of bridge deck plating, the same will be forwarded to you, when received.

The hawser supplied on board, is in steel wire of 120 fathoms length and $4\frac{1}{2}$ circumference; and four of 100 fathoms and 8" circumference in manilla. Total 5 hawsers & warps.

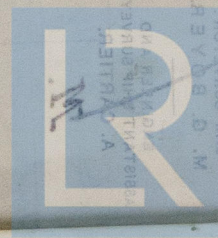
