Sir.

I beg to inform you that, the Steamer "Opio" or "H3," is now nearly finished. The vessel will be to charter by the "Compagnie Générale Transatlantique" of Havre; the vessel proceeds now, in a voyage for Cardiff ~~with~~ full cargo of coal, and back to Havre, afterward the discharging of half cargo 6000 tons the trials will be effected before the French Commission of reception. The last works, have been effected promptly, the freighter being very anxious to have the vessel to be disposed.

The equipment is now in order.

The preboard is traced, but not verified, that will be made next return of vessel.

I have to add that, when the vessel go down the river Seine from Rouen, the engine working, the air pump was damaged, the lower part

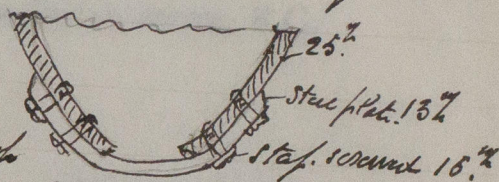

the lower part was staved forming an opening of 8 inches.  
The repair was effected at Havre by the attaché of the  
Comp. gen. Transatlantique, by a  
circular plate fitted in place & fixed  
by 48 screws - stop, in <sup>the</sup> cast-iron air pump  
for this moment it was not possible for fitted a new one, an  
arrangement will be made with the Director of Charente  
de Normandie when the vessel returns at Havre in a few  
time. The first entry Report, is in preparation and  
forwarded to you as soon as possible.
