
SHIPPING CASUALTIES.

LAMER JUVERNA GIVEN UP AS LOST.

Messrs Thomas M'Laren & Co., shipowners, Glasgow, the agents for the new steamer *Juverna*, which left the Tail of the Bank on Monday week for Kingston, are still without information regarding the vessel. There is little doubt that she has foundered with hands, and the agents have given up hope of hearing of her again. The crew of the *Juverna* numbered about 10 men. Captain John Lev, who belongs to Port St Mary, of Man, was in command, and other two Port St Mary men—John Watterson and James Peterson—were on board. No list of the crew is available, and it is probable that the others were engaged by the captain at the ship side.
