Reverting to your letter of the 14th March last, respecting the completion of the Special Survey No. 2 which is overdue on your steamer "LADY CORY WRIGHT", I beg to acquaint you that the Society's Surveyors at Southampton report that although the main boilers were submitted for survey there they were informed by the Master it was impossible to advance the Special Survey No. 2 on account of instructions from the Dockyard Authorities.

In the circumstances I think it well to enclose herewith a copy of a Circular recently issued by the Committee on the subject of the periodical survey of classed vessels, and to say that if it is not convenient to complete the Special Survey in question now the Committee will be glad if you will kindly make arrangements for a general examination of the steamer to take place, as suggested in enclosed Circular, and perhaps you will be good enough to let me know at what port this can be done. For the general examination a fee will be charged of £7. 7. 0.
