Dear Sir,

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 1st. instant respecting the steamer "LUCIANO MANARA" and to say that I have laid the same before the Committee ~~at their meeting to-day~~. In reply I am directed to inform you that after consideration of the circumstances the Committee feel that consistently with the course usually followed in similar instances a record of the casualty should be made against the vessel's name in the Register Book as described in my letter to you of the 13th. March, and this will accordingly be done.

I may add, however, that in the event of the vessel being refloated and repaired the notation of casualty will be withdrawn immediately upon the reclassification of the vessel by this Society.

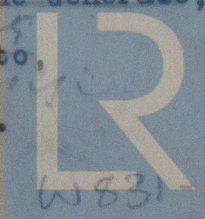
