Sir

I have to acquaint you that to complete the Boiler Survey of the Steamer "LORDAHER" and entitle this Vessel to record of B.S. 3.17 the main Boilers require to be examined and all safety valves adjusted under steam.

The Owners now state that the Vessel is due at Pauillac and that after discharging at that port, she will probably proceed to the Bristol Channel where the Survey will be completed. I shall therefore be glad for the Vessel to receive the necessary attention in the event of her arriving in your district.

I may say that on the 26th June last the Committee erred in action as regards the Special Survey No. 3 in view of the Vessel being under Government requisition, and I may also point out that this Steamer retains her class, subject to permanent repairs being effected to some indented shell plating at the first convenient opportunity.
