I am duly in receipt of your letter of the instant, respecting the steamer "LODANER", and regard thereto I beg to acquaint you that the Committee, who have had the matter before them, note that the vessel is under Government requisition and is now on her way home from the Argentine, and in the circumstances mention they have deferred consideration of the matter for the present.

As the vessel's main boilers became due for replacement so long ago as October, 1916, the Committee will be glad if you will kindly arrange for the necessary repairs to be held on the vessel's arrival, and I shall be glad to learn, in due course, when and where this may be done, in order that instructions may be furnished to the Society's Surveyors.
