With reference to the Classification in
Society's Register Book of the Steamer "LODANER",
the Special annual Survey, which became due on
the Vessel's Boilers, in October last, I beg to acquaint
you that to complete this inspection, which was partly
done at Newport in March, the main Boilers require to
be examined, and all the safety valves adjusted under steam.
I therefore be obliged if you will kindly let me know
the information of the Committee, when and at what
time I expect to be in a position to have this done.

At the same time, I think it well to point
out that the Vessel will become due at the end of the present
year for the Special Survey No. 3 prescribed by the
Rules.
